1. GENERAL INFORMATION

The Virtual International Programme (VIP) launched in the winter semester of 2020/21 provides an additional exchange opportunity for students from our partner universities twice a year. The programme includes a range of courses that are revised on a semester basis, as well as a selection of regular courses that are available continuously. VIP courses form part of JLU's curriculum, enabling JLU and international students to collaborate within a digital classroom.

The virtual exchange programmes welcome up to 350 virtual exchange students each semester. Students have the opportunity to select from approximately 40 courses offered by 8 faculties of JLU, open to Bachelor's, Master's, PhD and Teacher Training students. Recently, the course catalogue included courses taught in English, German and Spanish.

In the context of remote internationalization, VIP presents an opportunity to gain an international experience from the comfort of home, with a focus on inclusivity and sustainability.

- **RECURRING COURSES** – Always on offer: our regular courses are recurring, either available in the summer and/or winter semesters. High-quality teaching on fundamental topics.
- **COURSE CATALOGUE** – Current Topics & New Perspectives: we offer a semester-changing course programme to give our lecturers and students the opportunity to focus on current academic, political, and economic topics and trends.
- **INTERDISCIPLINARY SEMINARS** – Led by faculty members from diverse disciplines, fostering cultural and academic exchange. Through academic dialogue and interactive learning, students acquire intercultural and digital competencies, along with teamwork skills, enhancing their virtual study experience.

5. E-MENTORING TEAM & ACCOMPANYING PROGRAMME

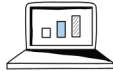
The E-Mentors are JLU students from various faculties who assist international virtual students by providing personal advice on student-related matters via email and video calls, as well as offering technical support.



- **ONLINE ORIENTATION WEEK FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS (OWIS):** At the beginning of each semester, JLU hosts a virtual orientation week tailored for international students. Various online sessions offer essential information about the university's structure, along with guidance on the IT tools and administrative systems used at JLU.



- **ONLINE INFORMATIONAL & SOCIAL EVENTS:** Throughout the semester, we organize a range of online meet-ups and social gatherings to address academic inquiries and encourage student connections. Every first and third Monday of the month, Question Monday offers insights into relevant topics related to studying at JLU. Additionally, every Wednesday, we host a relaxed Online Get-Together, providing students with the chance to socialize outside of academic settings. Participants can join discussions, ask questions, engage in online games, or even find a Tandem partner.
