Enrolment rules for Erasmus+ **student** mobility for studies



1. Ensure your **student status** (full-cycle UL student) **during mobility**.
2. Applications for all fields are open to any gender/sex or age group.
3. Applications are open to any (Polish/EU or other) **citizenship**.
4. You can spend up to **12 months abroad in total**, for each **study cycle (your Bachelor, Master, or PhD degree cycle of studies)**.
5. You can spend up to **24 months abroad** for your study cycle if you are a **long-cycle (direct Master's degree) student**.

Enrolment rules for Erasmus+ **student** mobility for studies



6. Your earlier Erasmus+ student mobility for studies, traineeships or BIP (with or without a grant) will be counted to **the Erasmus+ total capital** for your study cycle i.e., as part of the 12-month sum for 1st, 2nd or 3rd cycle, or 24 months for long-cycle (direct Master's degree) studies.
7. If you go on an Erasmus+ during your **final study year**, please have with you and present your **Thesis Supervisor's permission form**.
8. If you are a student of the **final year (Bachelor degree cycle)** – submit a **Declaration** to continue your studies for the next study cycle at the same UL Faculty, in which you are currently studying.

Enrolment rules for Erasmus+ **student** mobility for studies



9. Your stay on the Erasmus+ should be **longer than 2 months Erasmus+ but shorter than 12 months**. The study mobility period should start after **1st August 2026**
10. There is the option of extending study period for the summer semester 2026/27, but **with zero grant for the second semester (means without funding for the second semester)**.

The rules for the extension of the study mobility are not yet arranged at the UL.

Enrolment rules for Erasmus+ **student** mobility for studies



11. General UL criteria for mobility applicants:

- **Grade average** (3,7 or higher).
- **Ability to use the foreign language** of instruction (i.e. classes) at the chosen University.
- Stated earlier participation (if any) in mobility for studies/placement within the Erasmus+, LLP Erasmus, FSS, or Campus Europae – **first time mobilities may have priority.**
- possible additional criteria at the second stage of selection at the student's home faculty
- **High degree of motivation.**

Group 1 – EUR 670 per month: Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Ireland, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Norway, Sweden, Italy, the UK

Group 2 – EUR 670 per month: Cyprus, Czech Republic, Estonia, Greece, Latvia, Spain, Malta, Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia

Group 3 – EUR 600 per month: Bulgaria, Croatia, Republic of North Macedonia, Hungary, Lithuania, Romania, Serbia, Turkey

The Erasmus+ scholarship is paid for max. 5 months = 150 days from the Erasmus+ KA131 project which should be awarded to the UL in the Call 2025 and 2026.

ERASMUS+ GRANT RATES at the University of Lodz



Extra financial support of EUR 250 monthly for students:

- social benefit receivers. Only for students receive a social grant from the University of Łódź in the summer semester 2025/26)
- with a certified disability
- those who have a child under 8 years of age (upon presentation of the child's birth certificate)
- and persons with the right of asylum or refugee status in Poland (a document confirming the status issued by the Office for Foreigners is required)

Extra financial support of EUR 250 monthly for students with certified disability + possibility of additional funding (additional application form – actual costs). A special application published on the website of the National Agency of the Erasmus+ Programme.

The funding for these people is valid in the same amount in the extended (summer) semester.

Note: A student may only receive **one allowance of EUR 250 monthly. Allowances for students with fewer opportunities are not cumulative.**

ERASMUS+ GRANT RATES at the University of Lodz



Lump sum to cover travel expenses – "green travel" (train, bus or carpooling-a joint journey of at least two students on the same route for the same purpose) and standard travel (plane, individually by car), depending on the distance of Łódź and the city of the host university

Support for travel days - up to 6 days (if, green travel) and up to 2 days (if, standard travel) - additional individual support to cover travel days for one-way and return trip

A participant using the "green travel" lump sum must undertake the journey by sustainable means of transport in both directions and must submit to the International Centre (after completion of mobility) tickets with daily travel dates, and in the case of shared car travel, a declaration of the travel dates.

The financing rules of the Erasmus+ student mobility for studies will be defined in a separate documents.
