

XXIVth CONFERENCE ON THE HISTORY OF LOGIC Cracow, April 28–30, 1978

The XXIVth Annual Conference on the History of Logic was held at the Polish Academy of Sciences, Cracow Branch, on April 28–30, 1978. The Conference was co-organized by the Department of Logic, Jagiellonian University at Cracow, together with the Section of Logic of the Institute of Philosophy and Sociology, Polish Academy of Sciences, and the Institute of Mathematics, Pedagogical University of Opole with the Organizing Committee composed of: J.
