## Rules of functioning of the UL Student Dormitories in the academic year 2021/2022

- 1. Students/doctoral students are accommodated in double rooms, in case of not using all the places, it is possible to apply for a single room.
- 2. The use of the quiet study rooms and the laundry room shall be possible only after prior written notification at the reception.
- 3. Kitchens shall be made available in compliance with the rules of the sanitary regime.
- 4. In public areas (corridors, kitchens, laundries, quiet study rooms) the following still applies:
  - obligation to wear face masks in such a way so as to cover mouth and nose at the same time; face masks and disinfecting liquids are available at the reception,
  - obligation to disinfect hands (liquid dispensers are also located at the reception).
- 5. Contact via phone or e-mail with administration of a dormitory is preferable.
- 6. Following Announcements, Regulations and Rules posted on the website cos.uni.lodz.p and checking e-mail boxes in force at the UL is recommended. It is there that detailed announcements pertaining to individual UL student dormitories will be sent.
- 7. On the premises of the building there are instructions pertaining to:
  - hands hygiene, coughing and sneezing behaviour, keeping social distance
  - behaviour in the event of suspected infection.
- 8. In the event of suspicion of infection or detection of a virus in a resident or employee, the procedures will be coordinated in agreement with the Sanitary Inspectorate (Sanepid), including quarantine of the entire building or its part.

## In order to minimize the risk of infection remember to:

- 1. Cover your mouth and nose in public areas (kitchen, corridors, laundry room, study rooms, elevator)
- 2. Get equipped with personal protection equipment (protective face masks, disposable gloves)
- 3. Dispose of used face masks in the waste containers intended for this purpose.
- 4. Remember to disinfect your hands.
- 5. Keep social distance.
- 6. Avoid close contact with ill people, especially those respiratory symptoms.
- 7. Comply with all the Instructions, Announcements and Regulations of the University Authorities.

Procedures to be followed in the event of disease symptoms, including suspected coronavirus infection, are described in <u>Annex 3</u> to this Rector's Announcement.
